- 1) Where have you spoken? (WBO is looking for speakers with good speaking skills)

Please provide a tape, CD or link to a podcast
- 2) A topic that would interest many of our target audience, such as:
 - a) leadership
 - b) marketing
 - c) business development
 - d) negotiation skills
 - e) security
 - f) legal
 - g) philanthropies
 - h) communications
 - i) new tools and techniques to help people in business be more effective
 - j) Email strategy (spam, etc)
- 3) A topic that provides "take-aways" for the attendee to improve their business; an idea or skill that can be implemented immediately without further training.
Answer the question: What are the benefits to the attendee?
- 4) Would you be willing to participate on a panel, rather than speak alone?
- 5) Can you bring an outside draw from your colleagues, clients and friends by announcing it via email?
